Terms and Conditions

NSF CHEQUES

A NSF fee of \$35.00 shall be levied for any NSF Cheques received, which must be replaced with a certified Cheque or other guaranteed form of payment. Failure to pay within 10 days will result in membership cancellation.

FEE PAYMENT

Applications will not be processed unless accompanied by appropriate fees. Payment is due upon registration. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, Visa or Mastercard.

All skaters wishing to participate in private coaching, Skate Canada testing or competitions of any kind must be "Members in Good Standing" (ie. paid in full). Payments to professional coaches for private lessons are not the responsibility of the MSC and are to be arranged between the skater, parent and professional coach.

REFUNDS

A fee of \$35.00 will be charged for any cancellation of membership prior to the start of skating. There will be no refunds except for medical reasons, accompanied by a doctors note and approved by the MSC Board.

BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDE

Any skater interfering with or endangering the safety of the other members or staff will be asked to leave the arena immediately. Recurring disciplinary actions may be grounds for membership cancellation.

SAFETY

Skate guards are to be worn at all times unless you are on the rubber mat at the rink entrance or on the ice. This is not only a safety regulation but also a sensible practice to protect your skate blades. **Please use the dressing rooms at all times and keep the lobby free of skating apparel.**
